Element	Directions	Student Composition
Tell	What is your setting? (Something ordinary that you can make strange)	Ex) playground, house down the street
Tell	What good diction will you use? (pick 2 from vocabulary, "The Black Cat", <i>The Shining</i> , and <i>Salem's Lot</i>)	
Sketch	Draw a picture of your setting. Keep in mind the diction from above, turning something ordinary in to something strange, and using all your senses.
